**ARIDE Course Schedule**

With the increase in drugged driving, the Michigan Office of Highway Safety Planning (OHSP) coordinates the Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) program. The 16-hour course is designed to increase an officer's ability to observe, identify and articulate the signs of impairment related to drugs, alcohol, or a combination of both.

Probation officers who have attended have found it beneficial – especially as it related to identifying impairment by offenders on their caseload.

Demand for ARIDE training is high, however, a small number of seats can be filled by probation officers to attend. Attendance will be determined on a first-come, first-served basis.

There is no cost to attend this federally funded OWI enforcement training. Compensation for officer time is not provided.
